It is a crucial phase for the Tourism Industry, with the possibility to recover from the pandemic emergency and a renewed attention to sustainable shared practices based on needs for authenticity. <u>CEnTOUR project</u> has been supporting 65 Tourism SMEs from Italy, Spain, Greece, Moldova and North Macedonia in the transition to circular practices, considering fundamental to put SMEs in contact with one another, discuss and elaborate the pros and cons of different choices towards sustainable solutions, as the most effective way to develop common strategies, rethink the value chain decreasing the environmental impact create meaningful jobs, purchase locally and promote the sense of place where one belongs.

This event aims at questioning where the tourism sector is going in terms of sustainability and on what aspects it should focus in the future, by presenting the results of the Project, with a specific focus on Circular Economy Facilitators and companies strategies, identifying their future steps in light of what they have achieved within CEnTOUR.
