

EUROCHAMBRES Circular Economy Report

- Based on the definition of the Ellen
 MacArthur Foundation ('butterfly')
- Quantitative analysis of 9 sectors
- Sided with 9 case studies
- Starting point for debate

CIRCULAR ECONOMY - an industrial system that is restorative by design

Hospitality & Food Services



- Green Procurement
- a) Corporate & Supplier Code of Conduct (e.g. impact reduction targets)
- b) Seasonal & local & certified products
- Reduce-Reuse principles in most products
- a) Smaller food portions (to reduce waste)
- b) Reusable packaging for hygiene products



Waste Management (an overarching topic)

Ex.: Plastics

- a. Eco design-> rethinking the shape, glues, inks, and need of certain products
- b. Recycling-> harmonised packaging, collection, and sorting
 - c. REUSE-> reusable and biodegradable packaging



Ex.: Construction

- a. Landfill ban
- b. Network of waste recovery plants
 - c. Modularity
- d. Renewable and recyclable materials





Conclusions

Sectoral Analysis

- Necessary to focus on shareable, modular, re-usable, easily repairable, and durable products/technologies
- Large investments needed, but high potential benefits in the longterm:

	2017-2025	by 2030
Mobility	135 billion €	280 billion €
Food	72 billion €	127 billion €
Construction	107 billion €	150 billion €

- Legislative incentives for innovations focusing on repair, reuse, and durability
- Funnelling investments
